Here is a list of supplies that your child will need for 6th grade:

- 1 hard shell pencil box
- 1 pencil sharpener*
- 2 white erasers*
- 1 pair of scissors*
- 2 different colored highlighters*
- 1 box (24 pack) of Crayola crayons
- 1 box (24 count) of Crayola pencils
- 6 glue sticks
- 2 Post-It Note Cubes (400 count, 3 in. by 3 in.)
- 4 boxes of 12 - #2 pencils
- 4 3 subject spiral notebooks regular (colors must be blue, red, green)**
- 2 composition notebooks
- 4 sturdy pocket folders (Colors must be blue, red, green, orange/yellow)**
- 2 packages WIDE RULED loose leaf paper
- 1 sports cap water bottle
- GIRLS ONLY: 1 box of quart or gallon-sized Ziploc bags
- BOYS ONLY: 1 package of baby wipes (to keep our classroom clean)
- 4G Thumb drive (USB) for research
- 1 -2" binders for Math with dividers
- 1 box of Kleenex
- \$3.50 for Tennis Balls for chair (I order in bulk)

*All supplies marked with an *: Please label with your child's name and place into their pencil box that should be label with their name.

**Please label folders and notebooks with your child's name and the following labels: red is "ELA," orange/yellow is "Math," green is "Science," and blue is "Social Studies."
